Four Million Cumulative Tons of LNG Shipped from Yamal LNG

Moscow, 29 August 2018. OAO Yamal LNG today announced the project has shipped four million tons of cumulative LNG.

Yamal LNG reached the fourth millionth ton shipped on the 54th cargo loaded from the LNG plant since the launch of the first LNG train in December 2017. Currently, there are two LNG trains in operation with total capacity of 11 million tons per annum, and both LNG trains have reached design capacity. The commissioning works on the third train are ongoing.

Note

Yamal LNG is constructing a 17.4 mmtpa natural gas liquefaction plant comprised of three LNG trains of 5.5 mtpa each and one LNG train at 900 thousand tons per annum, utilizing the hydrocarbon resources of the South-Tambeyskoye field on the Yamal peninsula located in the Arctic territory of the Russian Federation. The first LNG train commenced LNG production in the fourth quarter 2017 with the loading of the inaugural tanker on 8 December 2017, and the first cargo was dispatched from the second LNG train on 9 August 2018. Yamal LNG shareholders include: PAO NOVATEK (50.1%), Total (20%), CNPC (20%), and the Silk Road Fund (9.9%).
